- Students **must** request a graduation check from the School of Music Student Services Office approximately 1 year prior to their expected graduation date. Graduation checks before that time should occur with the student's MEMT advisor.
- Students must do the following during their final semester
 - register to take the PLT (Principles of Learning & Teaching) test
 - register to take the Praxis II Music Content test during the final semester.
 - check their curriculum sheet to see that they have met all of the graduation requirements for the MEMT Division.
- Students must do the following prior to graduation:
 - students must submit their application for graduation online through Enroll and Pay at the beginning of their last semester.
 - successfully complete their major applied instrument (422)
 - turn in Blue Repertoire card on or before the end of the final semester
