1. Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher.
2. Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher in MEMT Courses
3. A grade of "C" or better in each of the following courses:
MEMT 150, MEMT 196, MEMT 250, MEMT 251, MEMT 296.
4. At least 50 semester hours of college credit.
5. A signed applied music recommendation form verifying successful completion of the first semester of Sophomore Level lessons.
6. Successful completion of the Application form (typed).

Students must successfully complete Pre-Practicum Quiz Out #2 before entering their first MEMT 396 Clinical Practicum.

- Upon acceptance to internship site students must complete and turn in the "pink" Music Therapy Internship form to the MEMT office.

Students must do the following in their final semester prior to leaving for internship:

- check their curriculum sheet to see that they have met all of the graduation requirements for the MEMT office.
- submit their application for graduation online through Enroll and Pay.
- successfully complete their major applied instrument (422 Sr. Project Lesson).
- turn in their Blue Repertoire card.
