School of Music Graduate Program Timelines Master of Music Education Program, MME Degree

These are general timelines for degree completion, based on regular admission, full-time enrollment, and satisfactory progress. We expect our students to make every effort to complete their master's degree within two-three years (average for most programs, including part-time programs). Enrollment in the summer is not required for master's students but may reduce your time to degree if courses are available. The following timeline summarizes the School of Music's expectations for student progress. Please note the academic year runs from fall (August) through summer (July).

Year One

- Attend New Graduate Student Orientation and any required trainings (e.g. New GTA Training).
- Begin coursework (700+ level recommended) to complete core requirements Note some courses are only offered in a given semester or year, so plan accordingly.
- All MME students must take MUSC 812 (or an equivalent course approved by advisor) or request a waiver from the Music Education Area Coordinator.
- Identify your faculty advisor and track your program degree requirements. > Graduate Credit Policy
- Plan your Master's <u>Graduate Advisory Committee</u> (minimum of three members of the <u>Graduate Faculty</u>).
- Participate in academic & professional development activities and apply for <u>Student Opportunity</u> and Graduate Student Travel Fund.

Year Two+

- Complete coursework Send updated Degree Progress Check Sheet to advisor for final review and <u>musicgrad@ku.edu</u> to request a graduation audit.
- Identify your faculty committee (minimum of 3 Graduate Faculty, see committee requirements and submit the Advisory Committee Approval Form.
- Discuss PhD options with faculty advisor (recommended).
- Thesis students submit the Research Proposal Approval Form for committee approval.
- Finalize Degree Progress Check Sheet and submit your <u>Exam Authorization Form</u> to <u>musicgrad@ku.edu at least 2 weeks prior to final master's exam</u> Contact your committee members to discuss your progress and plan for exam requirements.
- Complete <u>Graduation Checklist</u> Requirements Graduation Deadlines are posted in the <u>School of Music</u> Graduate Calendar.
