Concerned About Someone...

Submit a CARE REPORT.

Provide as much information as you are comfortable. Care reporting is designed to encourage early identification of individuals who may be experiencing difficulty coping with their environment or a life circumstance. You are not required to diagnose a student or worry that you will get the student in trouble. Care reporting is assigned to the Student Care Referral Team (SCRT). Together Student Support and Case Management and SCRT assist University of Kansas students, staff, faculty, and family members who have concerns about a specific student's behaviors and/or well-being and do not know where to turn.

Hope@CAPS

HOPE@CAPS is a program through KU's Counseling and Psychological Services in which graduate students are trained to provide Mental Health Peer Education to other Jayhawks. Our Peer Educators are trained and accredited to provide supportive listening, assist in brain storming solutions, and to assist in locating resources for their peers. Our Peer Educators are accredited through NASPA, The Association of Student Affairs Administrators in Higher Education.

An Ombuds is...An **expert** in conflict management that complements other parts of the university by acting as a **confidential, independent, informal, and impartial** resource for **all members** of the university and by providing periodic **feedback** to the university about trends.

What does the KU Ombuds Office offer?

- > Provides a space to have an “off the record” conversation
- > Offers confidentiality
- > Space to explore options, understand policy, connect to experts on campus
- > Not a “mandatory reporter” of discrimination
- > When you are not sure where to go, or how to get help with a situation AND you need a confidential, “off the record” conversation.

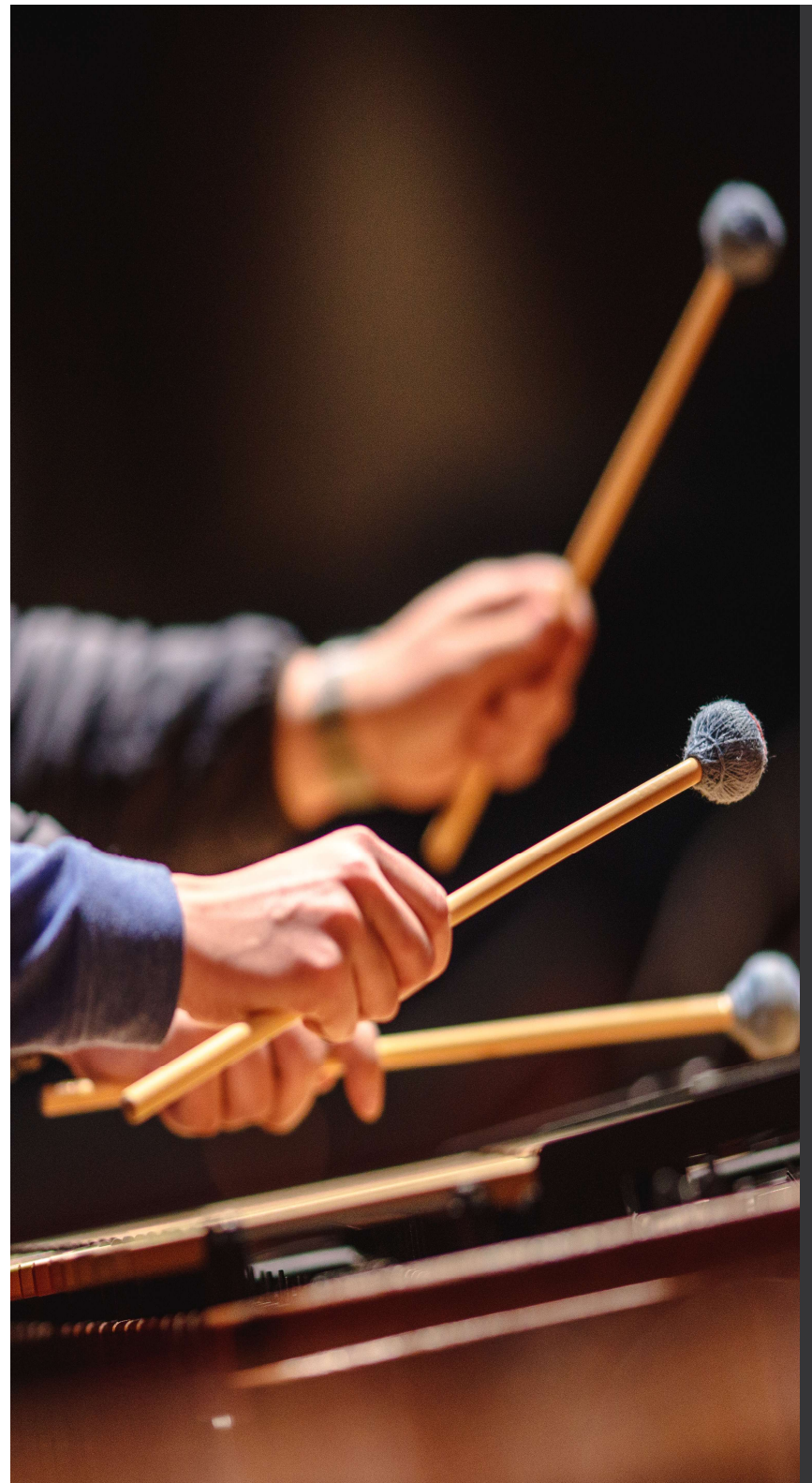
